COME BACK SHACK

\$- This is a favorite guilty pleasure; great burgers, drive through or dine in.! Get xtra come back sauce and order "the local" as an upgraded beef offering; good veggie burger too, with fried green tomato on top.





BOONESHINE BREWING

\$- This great local spot is very close to the cabins; you can sit outside, bring your dog and enjoy a local brew. Food truck also optional during busy times. Check out the merch in the back.

LOST PROVINCE BREWING

\$- Lovely Brewery downtown on King Street, usually a wait, but put in your name and shop at Mast General or the App Antique Market while you wait (or have a drink at Horton's Rooftop and Downstairs Bar; local hotel offering views on King Street)

PEPPERS

\$- perfect spot for a casual lunch, our favorite is a bite of the chicken teriyaki sandwich, an order of the mud pie, and a stop at the delish salad bar.

MAKOTO'S JAPANESE

\$\$ - Fun typical Japanese Steakhouse and a staple in Boone. A perfect place to take the family and have some amazing laughs. The staff is always so pleasant, and the wait time usually isn't too bad.

BOONE SALOON

\$-Great bar with a small, old school game room downstairs (don't get mad if you lose some quarters); fun for everyone in the family, located on King Street

CAPONE'S PIZZA

\$- Pick up and take out. Sometimes they don't answer the phone, but the
